Subject: Appeal to adopt the EU Multiannual Financial Framework and Recovery Fund

Your Excellency,

On behalf of [Ecopreneur.eu](https://ecopreneur.eu), the European Sustainable Business Federation representing about 3.000 green enterprises across Europe, we call on the Polish government to adopt the EU Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF) and the much-needed EU Recovery Fund before December 7, 2020.

The severe shock to the economy and workers created by the pandemic calls for solidarity among all EU member states. Without your support of the MFF and the NextGenerationEU Recovery Fund, structural aid recover from Covid-19 would stop, resulting in millions of European citizens suffering from economic and social hardship.

The release and speedy implementation of the MFF and NextGenerationEU is all the more urgent in view of tackling the current climate crisis by stepping up efforts to build a climate neutral, circular and just European economy.

Finally, the president of the Polish business association Konfederacja Lewiatan, Mr. M. Witucki, has recently declared in a French radio podcast that together with several employers' organisations, they too have appealed to the Polish government against the plans to block the EU budget for 2021-2027.

With the right actions, your government has a unique opportunity to overcome the current crisis and steer away from business-as-usual towards a future which is more resilient to shocks, safe, just, healthy, clean and prosperous.

A similar letter has been sent to Mr. Viktor Orbán, Prime Minister of Hungary, with a copy to Dr. Angela Merkel, Chancellor of the Federal Republic of Germany and Head of the EU Presidency.
